On 13 January 2014 and 21 February 2014 respectively, the European Parliament and the Council decided to consult the European Economic and Social Committee, under Articles 43, 114 and 304 of the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union, on the

COM(2013) 932 final – 2010/0095 (COD).

Since the Committee endorses the content of the proposal and has already set out its views on the subject in its earlier opinion CESE 966/2010, adopted on 14 July 2010<sup>\*</sup>, it decided, at its 496th plenary session (meeting of 26 February 2014), by 224 votes to 4 with 13 abstentions, to issue an opinion endorsing the proposed text.
