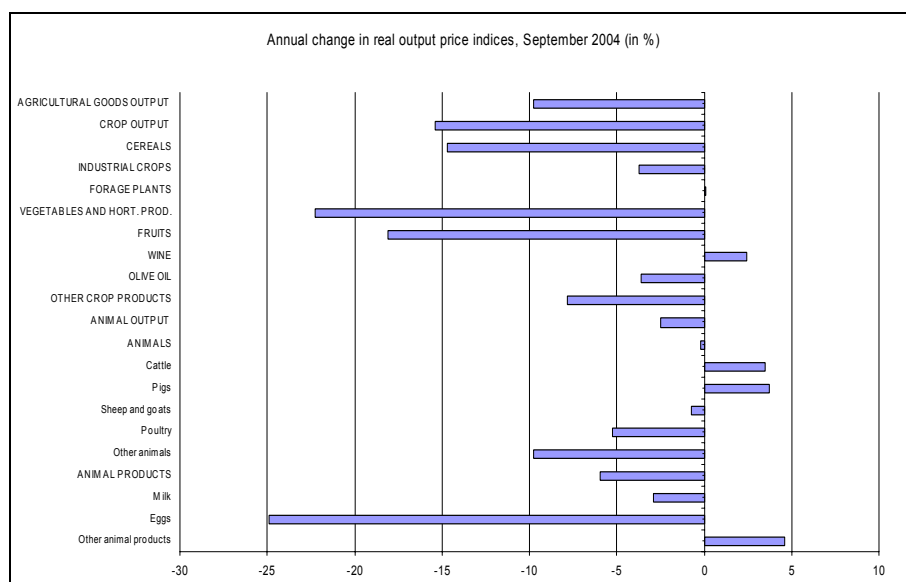


Agricultural price trends for EU-25 in September 2004¹

Agricultural output prices for EU-25 in September 2004, 11.3% lower, in real terms, than previous year's level²



- As in August, the price index for *Crop products* as a whole for September (-15.4%) was lower than a year before. All groups, except *Forage plants* (+0.1%) and *wine* (+2.5%) fell, especially *Cereals* (-14.7%), *Vegetables and Horticultural products* (-22.2%) and *Fruits* (-18.1%). *Wine* and *Olive oil* are the only products for which the evolution is the opposite to the one observed in the previous month: *Wine* varied from -1.4% to +2.5% and *Olive oil* from +3.2% to -3.6%.
- The overall price index for *Animals* and *animal products* was 2.5% lower than in September 2003. Separately, each of the two groups shows a decrease; -0.2% for *Animals* and -6.0% for *Animal products*. For *Animals*, increases were observed for *Cattle* (+3.5%) and *Pigs* (+3.7%). The most significant decreases appear in the price of *Other animals* (-9.8%) which reinforced the decrease of -1.4% observed in August. For *Animal products*, *Other animal products* was the only item with a price index higher (+4.6%) than a year before while *Milk* and *Eggs* registered decreases, particularly *Eggs* for which the fall was almost -25%.
- Output prices fell in seventeen of the twenty one Member States for which information is available with a decrease of 27.6% in Belgium and falls of between 10% and 20% in Spain, France, Italy, Hungary, Malta and The Netherlands. Among the four Member States with output price increases, the highest rate (+6.2%) was recorded by Portugal and the lowest by Denmark (+1.7%).

¹ Eurostat and the Member States are rebasing the agricultural price indices from 1995=100 to 2000=100, and all indices in this report are now expressed on the new base. This is the first *Statistics in focus* on agricultural price indices which provides an estimate for EU-25. Due to a lack of data, this estimate does not include: Cyprus, Latvia and Poland. In addition, Eurostat has made ad hoc calculations for Italy, Portugal and Spain, which provide the indices in the old base 1995=100 (further details may be found in the methodological notes).

² Unless otherwise stated, all index changes referred to in this *Statistics in Focus* are in real (deflated) terms.

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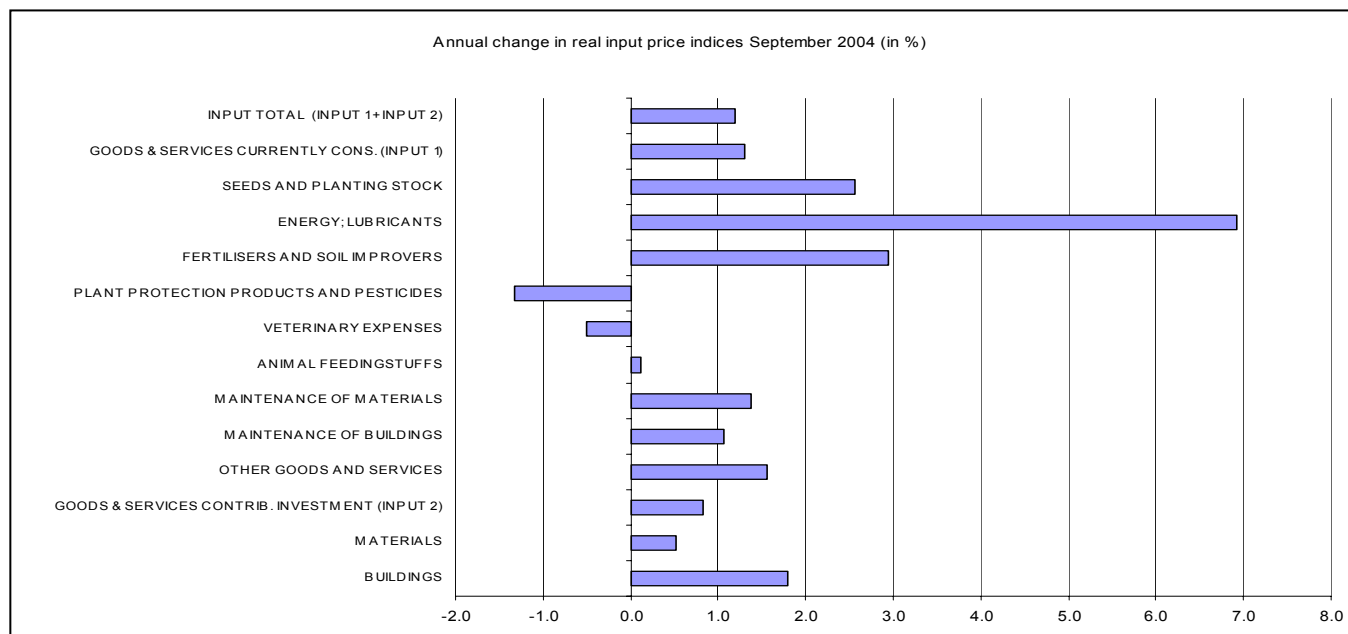

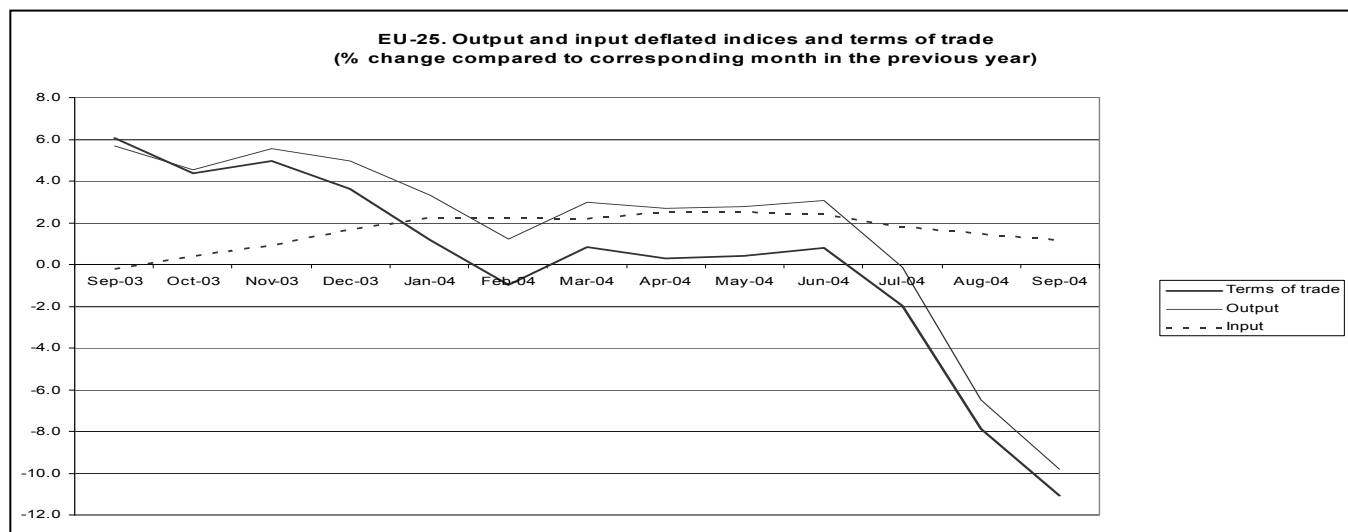


EU-25 Input prices, in real terms, 1.2% higher in September 2004 than in September 2003



- The price index for *Goods and services currently consumed in agriculture* (input 1) increased by 1.3%, continuing the trend that began in October of 2003. This rise was mainly due to higher prices for *Seeds and planting stock* (+2.6%), *Energy; lubricants* (6.9%) and *Fertilisers and soil improvers* (+3.0%). In contrast, prices registered a limited decline in relation to September 2003 for *Plant protection products and pesticides* (-1.3%) and *Veterinary expenses* (-0.5%).
- As in July and August, the price index for *Goods and services contributing to agricultural investment* (input 2) shows a small increase (+0.8%) in relation to the previous year.
- Across the twenty one Member States for which information is available (see table 3) input price indices ranged from -6.9% in Lithuania to +6.5% in Slovenia.

- The agricultural terms of trade, calculated by dividing the real output price index by the real input price index, moved similarly to the output index in the last twelve months, with a maximum in September 2003 (+6.1%), and a continuous fall in the rate of change since June 2004, which led to a decrease that in September surpasses 11%.
- The annual rate of change in September shows increases in only three Member States ranging from 2.3% for Luxembourg to 11.2% for Lithuania. The remaining eighteen Member States recorded decreases between 0.1% in Denmark and 25.4% in Belgium.

➤ ESSENTIAL INFORMATION – METHODOLOGICAL NOTES

Purpose of the Agricultural Price Indices (API): to provide information on trends in producer prices of agricultural products and purchase prices of the means of agricultural production. It uses the concept of *Market price* (or *producer price* in the context of agricultural accounts) which is defined as the price received by the producer *without* the deduction of taxes or levies (except deductible VAT) and *without* the inclusion of subsidies.

Base period: This concept is involved in the calculation of a price index, (i) in determining the weights for each product in the field of observation (*weighting year*) and (ii) in determining the base prices for these products. Furthermore, the term *base year* is also used to refer to the year for which the index is fixed at level 100. The base for the agricultural indices is changed every five years with effect from 1970. This means that rebasing is done for the years ending in "0" and in "5".

The five-yearly rebasing comprises three major changes:

(i) change of the base year; in the current rebasing this base year is 2000;

(ii) change of the weighting coefficients to adapt them to changes which have taken place in the last few years in the structure of European agricultural production and in the production techniques. With the rebasing of the EU API to the base 1995=100, the methodology of EU API was adapted in order to be closer in line with the new accounts methodology. In the current rebasing (2000=100) the same methodology is applied but the general structure of the EU output and input indices, i.e. the list of groups, subgroups, classes, subclasses and categories for which partial indices should be calculated, was changed;

(iii) update of the data used in order to account for changes in the markets;

Calculation of national indices: The EU Agricultural Price Indices are calculated by each Member State on the basis of the Laspeyres formula with base and reference year 2000.

The value weight attached to each elementary index in the output index is equal to the value of the sales of this product (exclusive of VAT) over the base period.

Means of production have to be valued at the purchase price which is the price the purchaser actually pays for the products. It includes *taxes less subsidies on products* (but excludes *deductible taxes like deductible VAT*).

The index is expressed in the form of the weighted average of the elementary indices with fixed base weights. The weights used are values (of sales or purchases) and not quantities. In the case of highly seasonal products such as fresh fruits and fresh vegetables the method of variable baskets with fixed monthly weights in the base year is used for the monthly indices. Thus for each of the two groups (*Fresh fruits* and *Fresh vegetables*) each Member State determines 12 monthly baskets of representative products.

Calculation of indices for EU: for this purpose the following steps should be applied:

(ii) Estimation of the API for the European Monetary Union (EMU) with the national weights.

(iii) Conversion of the EMU weight and weights of the non-EMU Member States into Purchasing Power Standards (PPS);

(iii) Calculation of the API for the EU with the PPS weights

Availability of data and Eurostat estimations: When writing these notes the following information was available in Eurostat:

Weights: For EU-25, weights for the new rebasing are available for all the Member States except Cyprus, Italy, Latvia, Poland and Portugal.

For calculating the weights for EU-25, Eurostat has made the estimation without Cyprus, Latvia and Poland. For Italy and Portugal weights were estimated from the Agriculture Economic Accounts.

Indices: In the new base, price indices for year 2004 are available for all the Member States except Cyprus, Estonia, (only output indices) Italy, Latvia, Poland, Portugal and Spain (only output indices). For Italy, Portugal and Spain (input prices) price indices were provided in the old base 1995=100. In addition, for the period 2000-2003 indices in the new base are missing for some countries.

Eurostat has recalculated the monthly indices in the new base for those countries for which indices are not available for 2004 and also, in order to be able to calculate the yearly rates of change, also for 2003.
