Since the Committee unreservedly endorses the content of the proposal and has already set out its views on the subject in its earlier opinions, namely SOC/597 – *European Social Fund+*, adopted on 17 October 2018, ECO/462 – *Regulation on the European Regional Development Fund and Cohesion Fund*, adopted on 17 October 2018, and also in its position papers SOC/651 – *Fund for European Aid to the Most Deprived (FEAD)/COVID-19 Crisis*, ECO/517 – *COVID-19: European Structural and Investment Funds - Exceptional flexibility*, it decided, at its 568th plenary session of 23 and 24 March 2022 (meeting of 23 March 2022), by 199 votes, with no votes against and 6 abstentions, to issue an opinion endorsing the proposed text and to refer to the position it had taken in the above-mentioned documents.
