Structure of agricultural holdings Czech Republic 2003

A farm structure survey was carried out in all EU Member States in 2003 (2002 in Poland). The detailed results are now available for Belgium, Czech Republic, Denmark, Germany, Estonia, Spain, France, Ireland, Italy, Latvia, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Hungary, Malta, the Netherlands, Slovenia, Slovakia, Finland, Sweden and the United Kingdom. Results for the other Member States will become available in the course of the next weeks. This Statistics in Focus is part of a series of country-specific publications, all following the same structure.

In the Czech Republic, in the autumn 2003 about 25 thousand agricultural holdings had an economic size of at least 1 ESU (European Size Unit)*.


- These holdings employed 153 300 AWUs (annual work units), the equivalent of 153 300 persons working full time;
- they made use of 3.6 million ha of agricultural area, which is on average 143.8 hectare per holding.


Amongst these 25 000 agricultural holdings,

- 30% made use of less than one AWU, while 31% made use of 2 or more AWUs:
- 31% used less than 5 ha, while 17% used 100 ha or more;
- 36% were mixed holdings, while 64% were specialised: cereals, oil seed and protein crops 18%, field cropping 17%, permanent crops 6%, dairies 5%, cattle fattening and rearing 5%, pigs and poultry 4%, sheep, goats and other grazing livestock 4% and horticulture 4% (of which 46% under glass);
- about 2% practised organic farming.

Amongst the 22 300 sole holders


- 16% were women;
- 39% were aged 55 or more, and 12% younger than 35 years;
- 32% had another gainful activity as major occupation.






>METHODOLOGICAL NOTES

The survey on the structure of agricultural holdings in the Czech Republic was carried out in the autumn 2003 on a sample base. Prior full-scale agricultural census has been conducted last time in 2000. The reference time of the agricultural survey 2003 was 30th September 2003. However for labour force characteristics the reference period was from 1st October 2002 until 30th September 2003.

The target population was all holdings (legal holdings, own-account farmers' holdings and other natural persons' holdings) reaching the threshold applied in 2000 census (now included in farm register). The sampling combined geographical location with aspects of legal form and economic size. Each municipality was arranged into the 54 strata taking into account their location in administrative regions and natural conditions of farming. Each municipality was assigned its weight based on the number of farms on it, and these weights were summing up in each stratum. Municipalities were random sampled in each stratum until the sample-weight reached 25% of the strata. Thus 1489 municipalities have been chosen (25.4%). All holdings of natural persons had been surveyed in these municipalities, as well as the small units under threshold and new holdings declared agriculture as one of their activity. Moreover all units with legal personality and all holdings of natural persons exceeded SGM 1.25 million Czech crowns (about 35 000 euros) were observed in the country. Altogether 27 475 units were visited (18 602 drawn from the register, 7 598 small units and 1 275 new holdings).

The data are multi-level checked. Partly completed questionnaires have been corrected via contact with the farmers.

For each activity ('enterprise') on a farm (for instance wheat, dairy cow or vineyard), a **standard gross margin (SGM)** is estimated, based on the area (or the number of heads) and a regional coefficient. The sum of such margins in a farm is its **economic size**, expressed in **European Size Units (ESU)**. 1 ESU is equal to 1200 euros.

Due to differences in the coverage of units of less than 1 ESU across Member States, these data are not comparable between countries. That is why the present analysis and graphs focus on the holdings of at least one ESU.

Each farm is classified in the community typology by its economic size and its **type of farming**, depending on the share of each enterprise in its economic size. For instance, a farm where breeding sows account for more than 2/3 of the economic size is classified as *specialist pig rearing* (type 5011). Depending on the level of aggregation, farms are grouped into 8 to 70 types.

Annual working unit (AWU) means the labour force working yearly like a worker employed on full time basis, it is 1800 hours (225 working days of 8 working hours per day).

The date of extraction of the data used for this Statistics in Focus corresponds to the date of completion of the manuscript.

Eurostat set up with the members of the 'European statistical system' a network of support centres, which will exist in nearly all Member States as well as in some EFTA countries.
